# **Background and Context**

- ► MSU Athletics
  - ▶ 23 Teams (incl. Track & Field twice indoor/outdoor = 2)
  - ▶~750 student-athletes (SA) (~800 to ~680, time of year)
- ► MSU two-FAR model
  - ▶ Dr. Bonnie Knutson & Dr. Michael Kaplowitz
  - ▶ 6 of original Big Ten schools have two-FAR model (Illinois, Iowa, MSU, MN, Purdue, Wis.)
- ▶ FARs work to ensure:
  - ▶ Student-athlete welfare and well-being
  - ▶ Institutional oversight Rules compliance/Academic integrity

# Student-Athlete Academic Success NCAA Report (FALL 2023)

#### NCAA Report

- ► Cohorts: 2013-2016 cohorts as per NCAA
- ▶ The NCAA's release typically focuses on GSR and 4-year FGR.
  - ▶ The GSR is an NCAA metric which allows athletics departments to compare themselves to their peers within an agreeable set of conditions. (For example, not being penalized for transfers who leave an institution in good standing.)

Football	69	59	50
MBB	88	58	50

# MSU SA Academic Success – GSR, FGR

- All S-A 4-yr FGR of 81% is all-time high!
  - matches the All-Student 4-year rate
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> highest in Big Ten (NW-95%, mich-83%, ILL-81%)
  - 7<sup>th</sup> highest among Power 5 conference peers;
     3<sup>rd</sup> highest among public institutions in that group
- Five sports posted 100% FGR
  - Gymnastics, Women's Track/Cross Country, Women's Tennis, Volleyball and Men's Tennis

# Student-Athlete Academic Success

GPA Report (FALL 2023)

- ► 2rd HIGHEST ALL-TIME DEPARTMENT CUMULATIVE GPA (3.3188)
  - ▶ all-time high is 3.3286 from Spring 2023
  - ► HIGHEST\_EVER POST\_FALL cumulative GPA
  - ▶ 26<sup>th</sup> consecutive semester over a 3.00 cumulative GPA
- ▶ 4<sup>th</sup> HIGHEST ALL-TIME DEPARTMENT SEMESTER GPA (3.3389)
  - ▶ 2<sup>nd</sup> Highest Fall semester GPA (behind pandemic-impacted fs20)
  - ▶ 22<sup>nd</sup> consecutive semester over a 3.0 semester GPA
- ▶ 20 of 21 TEAMS posted both CUMULATIVE & SEMESTER GPA 3.0 or better
  - ▶ 2<sup>nd</sup> consecutive semesters with 20 teams above both

# AC Ticket Policies – 2023-2024

#### ► FOOTBALL-Season Tickets:

- ▶ Athletic Council members are eligible for two (2) football complimentary season tickets
- ▶ Members <u>will be taxed</u> on the face value of the tickets
- ▶ If ticket location chosen has Spartan Fund Seat premium, members responsible for payment of <u>full</u> amount.
- ▶ <u>Personal use</u> only; not to be used for student-athletes, recruits, or high school coaches
- ▶ Parking passes available upon request as well, will be taxed on value of pass.
- ▶ No discount on single-game tickets

#### MEN'S BASKETBALL-Season Tickets:

- ▶ Athletic Council members can request two (2) men's basketball season tickets
- ▶ Same re: taxes; Spartan Fund seat premium; Personal use only; & No discount on single-game tickets

#### ► HOCKEY-Season Tickets:

- ▶ Athletic Council members can request two (2) hockey season tickets
- ▶ Same re: taxes; Spartan Fund seat premium; Personal use only; & No discount on single-game tickets

#### ► GO GREEN CARDS

- ▶ Athletic Council members are eligible to receive two (2) complimentary Go Green cards
- ▶ A Go Green card is good for one (1) admission to any of the following sports for the season: Men's & Women's Soccer, Women's Volleyball, Women's Basketball, Women's Gymnastics, Wrestling, Baseball, and Softball

# AC Ticket Use Report – 2023-2024

- Athletic Council members (12) (not including AD, FARs, S-A)
- Season Tickets Issued
  - ► Football pairs of season tickets issued to **9** AC members
  - ▶ Men's Basketball pairs of season tickets issued to 10 AC members
  - ► Hockey pairs of season tickets issued to 6 AC members
- Go Green Cards
  - ► Entry to Men's & Women's Soccer, Women's Volleyball, Women's Basketball, Women's Gymnastics, Wrestling, Baseball, and Softball
  - All AC eligible members able to pick-up Go Green Cards at the Ticket Office
